\*There is a committee created by Saudi Health Speciality to review and plan for Saudi Licensure Exam for all nursing graduates. The committee had developed a blueprint for the exam. The SNLE will start for 2016-2017 nursing graduates after they complete the internship year at July 2017.

Students are distributed to different colleges according to students' GPA. Many of the students registered to nursing college are not interested in nursing but entered by default. After the first year in nursing programme, many transfer to other colleges such medicine, applied medical sciences etc. according to their GPA.
